

# PROHIBITED

For visibility and safety reasons, runs are not allowed during dark hours, regardless if it is at night or early mornings.

The City does not have the authority to permit runs on state roads and state highways. That includes Washington Street and Ed Hall Drive.

Please do not park any vehicles on private property unless you have the owners permission.

Please do not block any driveways, where the owner or tenant can't get in or out.

Food sales are allowed after obtaining a temporary food permit.

## REQUIREMENTS

Unfortunately, the City of Kaufman can not provide police officers or firemen for your event.

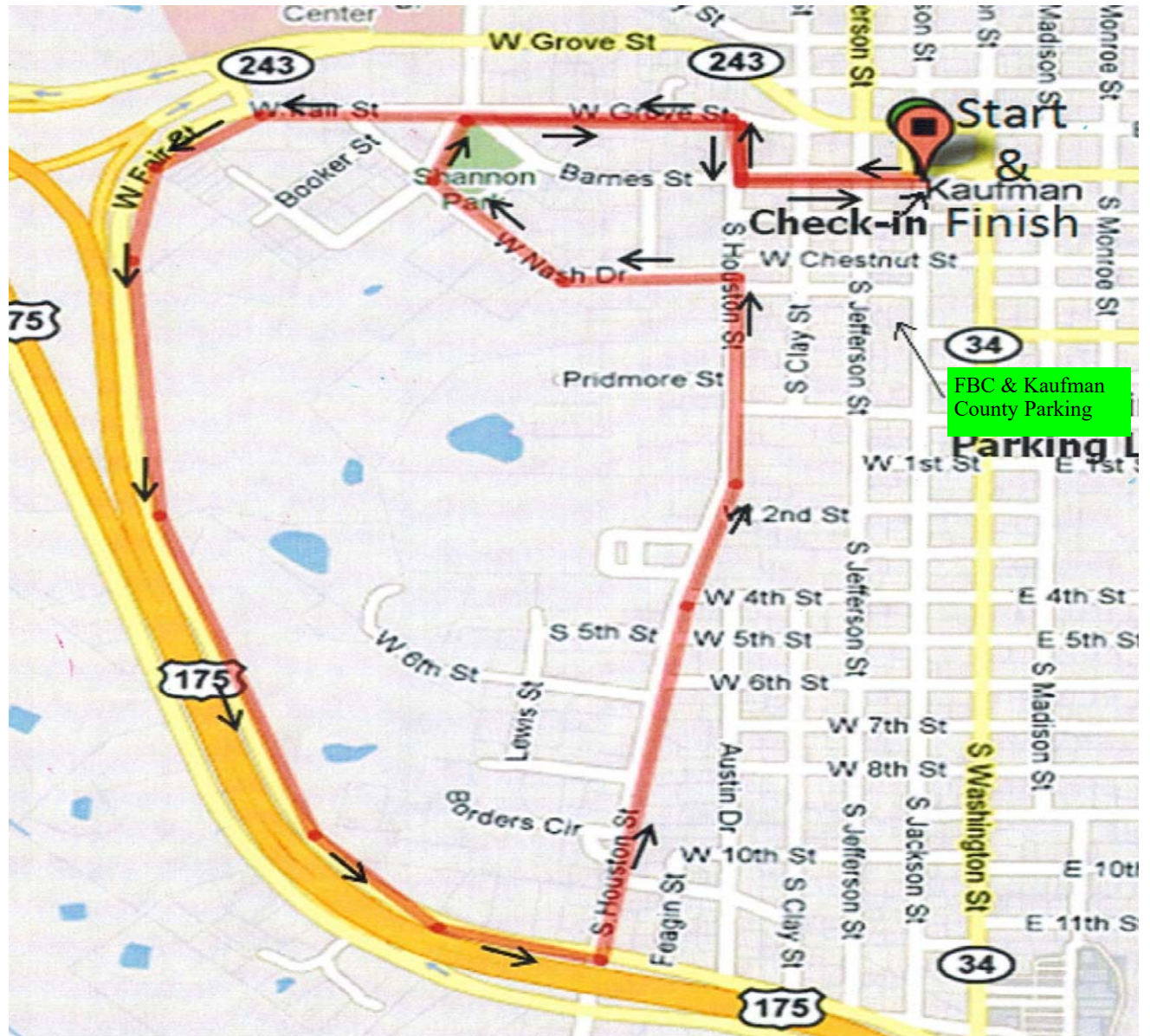
You will need to provide a stationary car, with its flashers on, near the entrance of Highway 175 during the entire run. The runners will have the right lane to continue on to South Houston Street. DO NOT BLOCK THE ENTRANCE TO HIGHWAY 175.

You will need to provide two cars, with their flashers on, to escort the runners. One car will be at the front of the first runner and one car will follow the last runner.

You will need to provide safety cones to close off the staging and finishing area.

Please clean up any and all trash from your event.

The attached route shown, has been pre-approved and is the safest and most economical routes in the City of Kaufman.



**PARKING** — The runners can park around the square or at the Kaufman County parking lot located in the 200 block of South Jackson. If you park at the First Baptist Church parking lot, located in the 300 block of South Jackson Street, please obtain permission from the church before doing so.
