

What do I need to know about bulk/brush service?

How often is bulk/brush collected?	Every week on your trash collection day (see map on reverse side for your collection day)
How much bulk/brush can I set out on the curb?	3 cubic yards (included with service). If more than 3 cubic yards is placed at the curb it will automatically be collected and invoiced to the resident on the next water invoice (up to 8 cubic yards per week) at a rate of \$12.50 per cubic yard. Large piles greater than 8 cubic yards will be tagged with a quote for special pick up or you can request a quote by calling 972.225.5252 or 800.32.TRASH.
Why the change?	Collecting the entire load each time keeps the City looking clean and neat and makes it more appealing to those wishing to relocate.
How should I place brush at the curb?	Leaves should be bagged; tree, shrub, and brush trimmings must be neatly piled together not exceeding four (4) feet in length or thirty-five (35) pounds in weight. Branches should not exceed 2 inches in diameter or 4 feet in length.
What types of bulky items can I place at the curb?	Bulk waste items include stoves, water tanks, washing machines, furniture, large appliances without Freon [®] and other individual items that are too large to fit in your waste cart. Non-acceptable items include construction or demolition debris, dead animals, hazardous waste, commercial/landlord cleanouts, stable matter, bagged trash or items not accepted by the landfill.
How much is a cubic yard?	The average washing machine or dishwasher is 1 cubic yard. The average refrigerator or small sofa is 2 cubic yards
